Enrollment Requirements:

- Admissions deadline for Fall August 15th / Spring December 20th- \$75 late fee charged after deadline
- → Students must complete the ACT test prior to registration of classes, 1) unless 21 or older by the admissions deadline or 2) unless student has 15 or more transferable credits
- → Minimum ACT score for English and math is 19. Minimum SAT score for English and math is 500
- → Students with expired ACT/SAT scores will not be required to retake ACT/SAT, but COMPASS testing will be required for placement. Call 800-645-1992 for the nearest COMPASS testing center
- → COMPASS testing is required for all students 21 or older unless transferring in the equivalent of MAT 1010 and ENGL 1010
- → Please see UVSC catalog for a complete list of enrollment requirements

Graduation Requirements:

- → Completion of a minimum of 120 or more semester credits with a minimum 40 credits upper division
- → GPA of 2.0 (C) or above, and students must matriculate into BS degree prior to application for graduation
- → Minimum 30 credit hours earned through course attendance at UVSC, at least 10 hours earned in the last 45 hours
- → Completion of GE and aviation technical credits required by Aviation Science Department
- → Completion of Commercial Pilot Certificate and Graduation Survey
