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Understanding these principles will avoid delay in receiving your Financial Assistance!!

Initial:

- I understand that the **first priority deadlines** are as follows: **Fall = May 1, Spring = October 1, Summer = February 1**. I understand that if I am eligible, the Student Financial Assistance staff will guarantee my disbursement by the first day of class if, and only if, the first priority deadlines are met. If I want to meet the deadline I should begin the process a minimum of **10 weeks** prior to the deadline.
- I understand that the last day of the 2004-2005 school year to submit application documents to the Financial Assistance Office is **June 15, 2005**.
- I understand that as the above deadlines approach it becomes very busy in the Student Financial Assistance office. Therefore, if I have a question that needs personal attention I may need to leave a message and wait to receive a return call. The best times to call are: Monday - Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Mountain time.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to keep my address and phone number current with the UVSC Records Department.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to stay informed as to my financial aid status, which can be obtained by logging into the OnAccess section of the UVSC website at http://onaccess.uvsc.edu (social security number and date of birth will serve as your username and password).
- I understand that I may need to check OnAccess often for any and all updates concerning my Financial Assistance.
- I understand that if I am a Global Aviation student, not flying at UVSC Provo, and want to apply for an alternative loan, I must submit the Release Form and complete the Alternative Loan Counseling Session found at <u>www.uvsc.edu/finaid/aviation</u>, step #8.
